



 - Paul would have been assumed to fit into this category in every new town.

- He had precious little time in each town for this reason
- He had to be <u>strategic</u> in choice of towns
- New believers had to become strong evangelists
- The Thessalonian believers, having endured <u>persecution</u> with Paul, held a special place in his heart.



Author's emphasis:

The Thessalonian believers were 100% ready to follow Jesus through persecution.

Believers must live in <u>total surrender</u> to the Gospel regardless of the cost to them personally.
