The "Melodic Line" (theme) at work in Exodus: moving from **slavery** to **worship**.

- I. Prohibitive laws (sins of commission)
 - 1) *Pre-marital sex/ cohabitation (v.16-17)
 - 2) Sorcery/ witchcraft (v. 18)
 - 3) Bestiality (v. 19)
 - 4) Idol sacrifice (v. 20)
 - 5) *Mistreatment of the defenseless (v. 21-24)
 - 6) *Usury (v. 25-27)

II. **Instructive** laws

(sins of omission)

- 1) Respect **authority** as from God (v. 28)
- 2) **Give** willingly to God (v. 29-30)
- 3) Remain **consecrated** (set apart as holy) to God (v. 31)
- 4) Maintain honesty and integrity (23:1-3)
- 5) Care for your <u>neighbor's</u> property as though it is your own (v. 4-5)
- III. More prohibitive laws
 - 1) *Do not inhibit the integrity of the justice system (v. 6-8)
 - 2) *Do not oppress a sojourner (v. 9)
