 - A. Supporting evidence
 - i. Covenant fulfilled (v. 3-4)
 - ii. Recognized by the angels (v. 5-8)
 - iii. Recognized on the earth (v. 9-13)
 - iv. Recognized as flowing from God's righteousness and judgment (v.14)
- II. Some results of God's faithfulness
 - A. A delay of the consequences deserved and opportunity to seek forgiveness. (Ps. 32:5, 1 Jn. 1:9)
 - B. God's faithfulness and justice work hand in hand to forgive and to change the very being of a person who desires to "walk in the light" (1 Jn. 1:6-9)
 - C. Our responses to God's faithfulness
 - i. Joyful shouts to the Lord for His faithfulness (Ps. 89:15-18)
 - ii. Sanctify believers until Christ's return (1 Thess. 5:23-24)
 - iii. Emulate faithfulness in our lives (Luke 12:35-48).
