 - Salvation brings new life!
 - Since you have been raised:

➤ You have **died** and...

your life is "**hidden** with Christ in God" (3-4)

- "Hidden" translated from *krupto* meaning... "to hide, escape notice, to conceal that it may not become known"
- **Christ** is your life
- The **world** does not know Christ and thus cannot understand those who follow Him.

4. Turn from your past sins (5-9)

1) **Put to death** (cut off, make survival impossible for) the earthly desires you may have, which are the cause of God's wrath on the world (5-7)

2) Give Christ's **peace** charge over your heart (15)

 - ii. **Sing** psalms, hymns, spiritual songs out of thankful hearts
