Reminder: a changed life is evidence of the reality and presence of Christ in a person's life. No change = no Christ?

The importance of understanding God's nature and character

God's holiness is preeminent

Holiness defined:

Reflections of God's holiness:

- 1) His works.
 - a. He created in holiness / righteousness (Ps. 145:17)
 - i. Angels created "blameless" (Ez. 28:15)
 - ii. World created "very good" (Gen. 1:31)
 - iii. Man created "upright" (Ecc. 7:29)
- 2) In contrast to sin (Gen. 6:5-8)
- 3) In His law
 - a. On men's hearts (Rom. 2:14-16)
 - b. Written for all to see (Ps. 7:12, 19:7-11)

We must come to understand not just how holy God *is*, but also *how* God is holy.
