How Christ is Manifest in Ministry

1 Corinthians 4:1-2

Negatively

- Do not lose heart
- Renounce disgraceful, underhanded ways
- Refuse to practice cunning
- Refuse to “tamper with God’s word”

Positively

- Commend ourselves to everyone’s conscience in the sight of God

How Christ is Manifest in Christian Living

Colossians 1:13-15

- He delivered us from the domain of darkness!
 - Domain = power or authority
 - Darkness = ignorance respecting divine things, ungodliness, etc.
- He transferred us to His Kingdom – now we live under the domain of light (God is light)
- Christ is the image of God. We are the image of Christ.
