 - ↪ Woe #1 Took financial advantage of widows.

- 4) Meticulous **tithing** (v. 23-24)
 - ↪ Woe #4 Neglecting justice, mercy, and faithfulness.
- 5) **Clean** the outside (v. 25-26)
 - ↪ Woe #5 Full of greed and self-indulgence.
- 6) Outwardly **righteous** (v. 27-28)
 - ↪ Woe #6 Putrefyingly unclean on the inside.
- 7) **Honor** past prophets and heroes of the faith
