## The Final Judgment

Common elements in Jesus' three parables from the Olivet Discourse:

- 4. Only **one** thing matters how each person responded to the main character.
- 5. Absent [main] character was gone an extended time.
- 6. Absent character returned and judged.
  - a. Rewarded those who <u>trusted</u> in Him and His character.
  - b. Punished those who rejected Him.
  - c. Trust, or lack thereof, was reflected in their actions.

Jesus answer to disciples' question (24:3) has three basic elements

- "I'm coming" (24:4-36)
- "Be ready" (24:37-25:30)
- "Judgement follows" (25:31-46)
   Breakdown of the judgement portion:
  - IV. Judgement of all **people** (v. 31-33)
  - V. The **righteous** rewarded (v. 34-40)
    - They didn't realize what they had done
    - We still need **encouragement** (Heb. 10:24-25)
    - They were righteous <u>before</u> their good works (cf. Jn. 6:29)
  - VI. The wicked **punished** (v. 41-46)
    - They were <u>surprised</u> (they didn't realize what they had not done)
    - Sent <u>directly</u> to "the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels" (v. 41c)
