God's holiness defined: moral/ethical perfection; set apart; God's righteous nature

God's holiness manifested in:

- 1) His works.
  - a. Created in holiness / righteousness. Ps. 145:17 [kjv]
    - i. Angels. (Even Lucifer) Ezek. 28:15
    - ii. The world. Gen. 1:31
    - iii. Mankind. Eccl. 7:29
  - b. Deviations from holiness
    - i. Some angels rebelled. Ezek. 28:15; ls. 14:12-17
    - ii. Man rebelled. Genesis 3
    - iii. Creation suffers. Rom. 8:20-22\*, Gen. 6:11-13\*
  - c. Keeping our focus on God. (Hab. 1:13) God in His holiness is so utterly repulsed by sin as to not even look upon it.
    - i. God's holiness when sin ran amuck Gen. 6:5-8
      - 1. What specific "wickedness" offended God? (vs. 1-2)
        - a. "Unholy matrimony" and sexual immorality
        - b. Something more: "wickedness," "continual evil imaginations"
- 2) His law.
  - a. On men's hearts. Rom. 2:14-16\*, 1:19-20
    - i. Certain moral codes are ingrained in people.
    - ii. Since we were created "upright" (Eccl. 7:29)
  - b. Written for all to see. Rom. 7:12, Ps. 19:7-11\*, Heb. 4:12
