 - "love" (agape) = "affection, tender and passionate attachment... [or] a virtue with such [power] that it is said to be the fulfilling of the law."
 - "abound" to be abundantly furnished with something; overflowing.
 - Such prevalent love of Christ that it flows out of our lives onto others.
