- Brings fear
 - People of Jericho were **scared** (Josh. 2:9-10; 6:1)
 - People of earth will be **fearful** and hiding (Rev. 6:15-17)
- "Trumpet" in Rev. 8:2 is most likely a shofar (ram's horn) as in Josh. 6
 - To direct the movement of troops in **battle**

A scene of worship (Rev. 8:3-4). Like the priest burning incense in the Temple.

A scene of terror (Rev. 8:5)

- The instrument of **worship** becomes an instrument of **destruction!**
