Sixth angel/ Second "woe"

- Angel #6 blows his trumpet
 - 1) "A **voice**" from the horns of the altar before God instructs the angel (13-15b)
 - a. Release four bound angels
 - b. They were **bound** at "the great River Euphrates"
 - c. They had been prepared for this very hour
- Action on earth (15c-21)
 - 1) Four bound angels released (15c-19)
 - a. 200 million mounted troops (16-17)

Are these demonic?

- v. Appear in connection with the four angels
- vi. Presented similarly to locusts in previous plague, who were demonic
- vii. Their actions called "plagues," not usually associated with human cause
- viii. Their horses do the killing and have many demonic elements
- b. Horses will kill 1/3 of humans (18-19)
 - i. Three plagues
 - > Fire
 - Smoke
 - > Sulfur
 - ii. Horses' power resides in
 - 1. Their mouths
 - Source of fire, smoke, sulfur
 - 2. Their tails
 - Like serpents with heads
 - Ability to wound
