- b. Gathers **innumerable** multitude for battle (v. 8b-9)

- i. March and **surround** "the camp of the saints" and the "beloved city"

- ii. **Fire** from heaven consumes them

- 2 Satan thrown into **Lake of Fire** (v. 10)

- a. Joins the **beast** and **false prophet**
- b. Nature of hell:
  - i. The torment is **constant**
  - ii. Torment has **no end**

### **Conclusions:**

- God's love is not **forced** on anyone... ever. Love, by definition, requires **free will**.
- Some will **reject** God's love no matter what.
- God's justice is absolutely **fair**... even if it is **delayed** by His mercy.
