How the Christian unintentionally commits a "treacherous act" of unfaithfulness (trespass)

Robbing **God** of what is rightfully His

- 1) Neglecting what *should be* set aside for God's use (Rom. 12:1) our entire being (time, energy, talents, body, resources)
- 2) Neglecting God's will/commands for our lives

Robbing **people** thereby sinning against God

3) Unfair business practices (including purchasing goods and services), taking advantage of people, etc.
