 - A. The last days bring times of **difficulty** (v. 1-5a)
 - 1. Recognizing self-absorbed, self-serving, pleasure-seeking people (v. 1-5a)
 - 2. Dealing with those [in the **church**] who appear godly but deny the power of godliness(v. 5b-9)
 - a. Avoid them (5b)
 - b. They pose a threat (v. 6-7)

Pastor's Note: Recognizing those in the church who *appear* godly but deny the power of godliness (2 Tim. 3:5) is critical and those people must be avoided. They endanger the weak and themselves. Paul gives strong words about those who will be "Disqualified Regarding the Faith."
