signs confirming Jesus' identity. The message "" will look at the structure of this section without delving deeply into the text. It's seventy-one verses, which is not huge to read on your own, but a bit more than we want to try to read, study, and exposit on Sunday morning. In fact, we'll only tackle v. 1-21 this time. If you can read it yourself, it will help you as we approach it from the perspective of walking with Jesus.
