How Jesus dealt with a "sorrowful soul" (Matt. 26:36-39)

- 1. He called on friends to **go with Him** in **prayer** (v. 36b-37a)
- 2. He took friends into **confidence** (v. 37b-38)
- 3. He got alone with God (v. 39a)
- 4. He **prayed** with **transparency** (v. 39b)
 - a. Confessed His struggle
 - b. Submitted His will to God's will

God is powerfully at work in your life through trials (Jas. 1:1-5)

- 1. **Testing** your faith (v. 3a)
 - a. "An experiment, attempt, trial, proving."
- 2. To produce **steadfastness** (v. 3b)
 - a. "The characteristic of a man who is not swerved from his deliberate purpose and his loyalty to faith and piety by even the greatest trials and sufferings"
- 3. To make you **finished** and **whole**, **lacking nothing** (v. 4)

Pastor's Note: If we can learn to "Meet God in the Midst of Pain and Suffering" we will be in a position to grow as He intends because of those challenges. We must, therefore, learn to count that joy
